OCTOBER – NOVEMBER TRANSLATION FORECASTS

Over the next six weeks, the forecast shows an overall **moderate level of submissions**, averaging around **760 pages per week**. A **significant peak** is anticipated during the October II plenary week, **with nearly 1800 pages** expected, followed by a short slowdown and a gradual increase in demand towards the end of the period.
